## Why in News

On August 7, 2021, Neeraj Chopra of Haryana won the gold medal in the javelin throw event at the Tokyo Olympics 2020.

## **Key Points**

- Neeraj Chopra took the country's first Tokyo Olympics gold medal in the individual category and finished first in the table with a **javelin throw of 87.58 m** in his second attempt.
- Neeraj is a native village of 'Khandara' in Panipat district of Haryana.
- Neeraj has been serving in the Indian Army since 2016 and is currently serving as a Subedar in the Rajputana Rifles Unit.
- Neeraj Chopra was awarded the Arjuna Award in 2018.
- Neeraj has won India's 10<sup>th</sup> Olympic gold medal, it is worth mentioning that 8 gold medals were won by the men's hockey team and 1 gold medal was won by shooter Abhinav Bindra (1<sup>st</sup> individual gold medal).
