Why in News

- Apart from this, archers Komolik Bari, Ankita Bhagat and cricketer Indrani Rai were also honored.
- On this occasion, Vishrampur MLA Ramchandra Chandravanshi was honored with **Birsa Munda Outstanding Legislator Award**.

Santhal's First Four-Lane Road 'Hansdiha-Mahagama' | Jharkhand | 23 Nov 2021

Why in News

On November 22, 2021, the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) issued a tender for the first four-lane road (Hansdiha to Mahagama) of Santhal Parganas in Jharkhand.

Key Points

- This four-lane road will be constructed from Hansdiha to Mahagama in Godda parliamentary constituency of the state.
- The length of this road will be about 52 km.
- Its construction will cost a total of Rs 955 crore.
- This road route will be connected to National Highway 133 (NH-133).
