



Draft to Include Two Districts of Uttar Pradesh in Delhi NCR | Uttar Pradesh | 01 Sep 2021

Why in News

- A draft has been prepared by the Government of Uttar Pradesh for the inclusion of **Shamli and Muzaffarnagar** districts in the **National Capital Region (NCR)**.

Key Points

- The draft was announced in the **40th meeting of the National Capital Region Planning Board**.
 - The meeting was held under the chairmanship of Hardeep Singh Puri, Union Minister of State (Independent Charge), Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, Government of India.
- Along with this, **Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority** was also declared as a metro centre.
- During the meeting, a **Combined Reciprocal Common Transport Agreement** was also signed for better transport connectivity between **Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Delhi and Rajasthan comprising the National Capital Region**.
 - With this, the movement of these states in the NCR region will be possible without any hindrance.
