Why in News

- The MoU was signed by Jitendra Singh Raje, Director, Skill Development, Madhya Pradesh, Dharamvir Singh of Siemens India and Usha Ganesh of GIZ India.
- Director Jitendra Singh informed that the objective of Indo-German Initiative for Technical Education Program (IGNITE) is to create a framework for high quality training in India based on the German dual vocational education and training model.
- He informed that four industry clusters of Madhya Pradesh and 34 government ITIs concerned have been selected for the IGNITE program. In this, 7 government ITIs have been selected in Gwalior-Shivpuri Industry Cluster and 9-9 government ITIs in Jabalpur-Katni Cluster, Sagar-Damoh Cluster and Rewa-Satna Industry Cluster.
- Under this MoU, Siemens India and GIZ. Announcements on the Occasion of International Women's Day | Madhya Pradesh | 09 Mar 2022

Why in News

 On March 8, 2022, on the occasion of International Women's Day, various programs were started by the Women and Child Development Department of Madhya Pradesh for the economic, physical and mental upliftment of the women of the state.

Key Points

- Keeping in view the procedural difficulties faced by women from banks, the Department of Women and Child Development has launched a special scheme to provide loans in collaboration with Punjab National Bank and Central Bank of India to overcome the paucity of funds. Under this, a loan of Rs 180 crore was made available to about 7136 women groups of the state.
- Aparajita martial arts training program was also started by the department for teenage girls. In this, 150 teenage girls of each district will be given 10 days training in Boxing, Judo, Karate, Taekwondo and Wrestling in collaboration with the Sports and Youth Welfare Department.
- A health test camp has also been started for the testing and treatment of the health and nutritional level of the women field staff of the Women and Child Development Department.
- Additional Chief Secretary Ashok Shah distributed symbolic keys of 8 autos and one e-rickshaw in collaboration with the bank to the beneficiaries of self-help groups on International Women's Day.
- Director Women and Child Development Dr. Ram Rao Bhosale informed that so far more than 41 lakh children in the state have got the benefit of Ladli Laxmi Yojana and this process is going on continuously. He said that the Panchayat which will celebrate the birth of daughters will be declared as 'Ladli Friendly'.

GPS tagging of Vultures in Panna Tiger Reserve | Madhya Pradesh | 09 Mar 2022

Why in News

• On March 8, 2022, Uttam Kumar Sharma, Area Director of Panna Tiger Reserve informed that for the first time in the country a unique initiative has been taken in collecting authentic information about the behavior and habitat of vultures in Panna Tiger Reserve in the state. Here GPS tagging is being done by catching the vultures.

- The work of GPS tagging on vultures in Panna Tiger Reserve was carried out by a team of researchers from Panna Tiger Reserve and Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun during winters in 2020-21 and 2021-22.
- The 25 vultures available in the Panna Tiger Reserve have been tagged with solar powered GPS devices. It includes 3D acceleration sensors. The GPS tag data is being tracked via satellite.
- This is a major achievement of the Vulture Telemetry Project. Vulture tagging is a well-planned initiative to prevent and conserve India's Old World vultures from extinction.
- With this unique initiative, 14 vulture species have been tagged and studied in 24 countries so far.

None of this is from India. There are 9 species of vultures in India. The state has got good results in the conservation of vulture species. The number of vultures has increased to 9446 in the year 2021

- Out of 9 species of vultures available in India, 3 species are endangered. Out of these 7 species are available in Panna Tiger Reserve. These include migratory species such as the Himalayan griffon/vulture, the Eurasian griffon and the sinerus, and migratory species such as the Indian long-billed vulture, the white-backed king vulture, and the Egyptian vulture.
- The number of vultures has decreased drastically in the last few decades. Efforts to conserve vultures started around 10-12 years ago across the country and the telemetry based project is a meaningful step in this direction.
- Through GPS tagging, important information about the movement of vultures, information about the route of migration and habitat etc. is available. This will ensure scientific management of vultures.
- In this system, blood samples have been taken in the health test of vultures along with GPS tagging. This will help to know the health status of the vultures. This information of vultures will prove to be important in making vulture management policies in future.

4 Important Decisions for Women Empowerment | Madhya Pradesh | 09 Mar 2022

Why in News

 On March 8, 2022, on the occasion of International Women's Day, Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan made 4 important announcements for women empowerment in the women empowerment-credit linkage program organized in Dewas.

Key Points

- The Chief Minister said that Women Finance Development Corporation would be strengthened in the state, Mukhyamantri Nari Samman Kosh would be established at a cost of Rs 100 crore, Mukhyamantri Mahila Udyam Shakti Yojana would be started and industrial parks would be set up in Indore and Bhopal to encourage women's enterprise.
- Mukhyamantri Mahila Udyam Shakti Yojana will help women to start their own enterprise and they will be able to become self-reliant.
- In order to encourage women's enterprise, industrial parks for women only will be built in Indore and Bhopal.
- Chief Minister Chouhan and BJP's National President JP Nadda handed over the keys to the Nutrition Food Plant to women self-help groups and distributed a loan of Rs 300 crore to them.

Natural Agriculture Board | Haryana | 09 Mar 2022

Why in News

 On March 8, 2022, Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal said in Kurukshetra that the State Government has decided to constitute a **Natural Agriculture Board** with the objective of promoting natural farming and providing facilities to the farmers for this farming.

Key Points

- The Chief Minister said that natural farming would be promoted to rid the people of the state from poisonous products and to save the health of the land.
- A provision of Rs 32 crore has been made in the budget by the State Government for the formation of Natural Agriculture Board.
- The Chief Minister said that work has also been done to give a concrete shape to the 3-year production-based plan for natural farming. Under this scheme 100 clusters will be formed and 25 acres of land in each cluster will also be linked with natural farming.
- After this, the work of certification, branding and then packaging will be done. Along with this, if the farmers suffer losses due to natural farming, then the amount of compensation will be provided by the government.

Vocational Skills Training Center in Dhanbad | Jharkhand | 09 Mar 2022

Why in News

 On March 8, 2022, Chief Minister Hemant Soren inaugurated the Vocational Skills Training Center online in Dhanbad under the 'Tejaswini Project' on the occasion of International Women's Day.

- On this occasion, the Chief Minister felicitated Anganwadi worker Nutan Devi of Dumka and Rita Shri Parya of West Singhbhum, and Amola Baski and Jaya Biruli, who did commendable work during the Covid transition period, by giving them certificates and citations.
- Minister of Women, Child Development and Social Security, Joba Manjhi said that Tejaswini Project is being implemented in 17 districts. 10.89 lakh girls are associated with the 12,800 club.
- Chief Minister Hemant Soren and Minister Joba Manjhi released the 'Setu Education Curriculum'
 on the occasion. The Setu Education course is starting in 17 districts of the state. Its objective is to
 connect girls of 14 to 20 years of education from 8th to 10th away from school.

Chhattisgarh Economic Survey Year 2021-22 | Chhattisgarh | 09 Mar 2022

Why in News

■ The Economic Survey of Chhattisgarh for the year 2021-22 was presented on the table in the Vidhan Sabha budget session on March 8, 2022.

- Key Points of Chhattisgarh Economic Survey Year 2021-22 are as follows -
 - The Gross State Domestic Product at market prices at constant prices in the year 2021-22 is estimated to increase to Rs 2,78,496 crore from Rs 2,49,683 crore in the previous year 2020-21, which is an increase of 11.54 percent.
 - In this, 3.88 percent growth is expected in agriculture and allied sectors (agriculture, animal husbandry, fisheries and forests), 15.44 percent growth in industry sector (construction, manufacturing, mining and quarrying, power, gas and water supply) and 8.54 percent growth in service sector.
 - In the year 2021-22, the contribution of agriculture and allied sector, industry sector and service sector in the Gross State Domestic Product at constant prices is 16.73, 50.61 and

- 32.66 percent respectively.
- In the Advance Estimates for the year 2021-22, the Gross State Domestic Product (Market Price) at prevailing prices is likely to increase from Rs 3,52,161 crore in the previous year 2020-21 to Rs 4,00,061 crore, which shows an increase of 13.60 percent.
- In this, agriculture and allied sector increased from Rs 74,652 crore in the year 2020-21 to Rs 81,317 crore in the year 2021-22, from Rs 1,35,985 crore to Rs 1,59,473 crore in the industry sector and from Rs 1,18,538 crore in the service sector. 1,31,920 crore, which shows a percentage increase of 8.93, 17.27 and 11.29 respectively over the previous year.
- According to the State's Gross Domestic Product Market Price Quick Estimate Constant Prices (Base Year 2011-12), there has been a decrease of -1.37 percent in the year 2020-21 as compared to the previous year 2019-20. In this, there has been a decrease of 5.48 percent in the agriculture and allied sector, -3.89 percent in the industry sector and -0.16 percent in the service sector, mainly due to the Covid-19 epidemic and lockdown.
- Per Capita Income (Net State Domestic Product) at current prices is estimated to increase from Rs 1,05,778 to Rs 1,18,401 in 2021-22 as per Quick Estimates for the year 2020-21, showing an increase of 11.93 percent over the previous year.
