



Uttar Pradesh to Rename 8 Railway Stations | Uttar Pradesh | 15 Mar 2024

Why in News?

Recently, the **Union Ministry of Home Affairs** has given its approval to the Uttar Pradesh government's proposal to rename **eight railway stations** in **Amethi district**.

Key Points

- The purpose of this decision is to preserve the **cultural identity and heritage of the region**.
 - The proposal, forwarded by the government suggests renaming Kasimpur halt as Jais City and renaming several intermediate stations like Jais as **Guru Gorakhnath Dham**, Bani as **Swami Paramhans**, Misrauli as **Maa Kalikan Dham**, Nihalgarh as **Maharaja Bijli Pasi**, Akbarganj as **Maa Ahorwa Bhawani Dham**, Warisganj as **Amar Shahid Bhale Sultan**, and Fursatganj as **Tapeshwarnath Dham**.
