Launched on 15th August 2019

Aim

- To provide **55 litres of water per person per day to every rural household by 2024** through **Functional Household Tap Connections (FHTC)**.

Implementation

- **Ministry of Jal Shakti:** Nodal Ministry
- **Paani Samitis:** Build, operate, manage, and maintain village water supplies.
 - **Members:** 10-15 (At least **50% Women**)
- **Goa and Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu (D&NH and D&D)** are the first 'Har Ghar Jal' certified State and UT in the country respectively.

Funding Pattern

- **Centrally Sponsored Scheme**
 - **Centre:** Himalayan and North-Eastern States - **90:10**
 - **Centre:** Other States - **50:50**
 - **100%** by the Centre for Union Territories

- Bottom-up Planning
- Women Empowerment
- Focus on Future Generation
- Skill Development & Employment Generation
- Greywater Management
- Source Sustainability
