Recently, C-DOT (Centre for Development of Telematics), the telecom R&D centre of the Government of India, won the <u>United Nation's</u> WSIS 2024 "Champion" Award in the "Mobile-Enabled Disaster Resilience through Cell Broadcast Emergency Alerting" category.

- The World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS)+20 Forum 2024 was conducted by the International Telecom Union (ITU).
 - ITU is a UN specialised agency for information and communication
 - technologies ICTs.
 - Founded in 1865, it is Headquartered in Geneva, Switzerland.
 - India has remained a regular member of ITU since 1952.
- The award recognized C-DOT's commitment to leveraging technology for societal impact and aligns with global initiatives like <u>Early Warnings for All (EW4All)</u> and the ITU's Common Alerting Protocol (CAP).
- At the <u>Al</u> for Good Global Summit (organised along with WSIS), C-DOT showcased its Al-powered solutions such as ASTR (Al and Facial Recognition powered Solution for Telecom SIM Subscriber Verification) for detecting fraudulent/unauthorised mobile connections.
