

## Kandukuri Veeresalingam

16<sup>th</sup> April was the birth anniversary of reformer Kandukuri Veeresalingam.

- Kandukuri Veeresalingam (16<sup>th</sup> April 1848 27<sup>th</sup> May 1919) :
  - He was a <u>social reformer</u> and writer from the **Madras Presidency** of British India. He was influenced by the ideals of **Brahmo Samaj**.
  - He is considered as the **father of the Telugu Renaissance movement.**
  - He was one of the **early social reformers** who **encouraged the education of women** and the **remarriage of widows** (which was not supported by society during his time).
  - He also fought against child marriage and the dowry system.
  - He started a school in Dowlaiswaram in 1874.
  - He constructed the 'Brahmo Mandir' in 1887 and built the 'Hithakarini School' in 1908 in <u>Andhra Pradesh.</u>
  - His novel Rajasekhara Charitramu is considered to be the first novel in Telugu literature.
