

## Kalaripayattu

Haryana youth made significant strides in embracing <u>Kalaripayattu</u>, securing the second position, just **after Kerala** at the <u>Khelo India Youth Games 2023</u>.

- Kalari Payat (Kalaripayattu) meaning 'Battleground' or 'Gymnasium'- (Kalari), 'Method' or 'Art' (Payatt), also known as Kalari, is an Indian martial art that originated in Kerala during the 3<sup>rd</sup> century BC to the 2<sup>nd</sup> century AD. It is now practised in Kerala and in some parts of Tamil Nadu.
  - It is considered one of the **oldest and most scientific martial arts** in the world, with a history spanning over 3,000 years.
- Kalaripayattu, a personal combat training system includes exercises to develop sharp reflexes for unarmed combat and skilful fighting using sticks, daggers, knives, spears, swords, shields, etc.
