Goa Liberation Day

<u>Goa Liberation Day</u> is celebrated on **December 19th** every year to commemorate the **state's liberation** from **Portuguese rule** in **1961**.

- The Indian government waited for 14 years after independence to move troops to Goa because it was a sensitive issue and the government did not want to risk a war with Portugal.
- In 1961, the Indian Government launched <u>Operation Vijay</u> and annexed <u>Daman and Diu</u> and <u>Goa</u> with the Indian mainland on 19th December.
 - As a result, Goa, Daman, and Diu became <u>Union Territories of India.</u>
- Goa continued to be a Union Territory till 1987 and then was given statehood by becoming the 25th state of India.

The Vision

- 30th May is celebrated as the Statehood Day of Goa.
