 - NSDC is a unique <u>Public Private Partnership</u> (<u>PPP</u>) enterprise working under the <u>Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship</u> (<u>MSDE</u>).
 - It was established to catalyse the skilling ecosystem, NSDC partners with the private sector to implement the <u>Skill India Mission</u>, focusing on efficient vocational training initiatives.
 It supports enterprises, startups, and organisations by providing funding, concessional loans, and innovative financial products to enhance skilling initiatives.
