- The Director of CSIR-IIP presented the institute's roadmap for 2024-2030, aiming to achieve <u>Vikasit Bharat</u> and highlighted achievements of institute such as Numaligarh Wax Plant, <u>Sustainable Aviation Fuel</u>, US Grade Gasoline, <u>Medical Oxygen Units</u>, Sweetening Catalyst, PNG Burner, and Improved Gur Bhatti.
- CSIR is one of the largest research and development (R&D) organisations, established in 1942.
 - It is funded by the Ministry of Science and Technology and it operates as an autonomous body through the <u>Societies Registration Act, 1860.</u>
- CSIR covers a broad range of fields from radio and space physics, oceanography, and geophysics to biotechnology, nanotechnology, mining, aeronautics, environmental engineering, and information technology.
