

Chief Minister's Rehabilitation Home Scheme

Why In News?

 On December 21, 2022, Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot approved a financial provision of Rs 28.23 crore for the 'Mukhyamantri Rehabilitation Home Scheme' for proper housing of homeless, old age, working women and helpless/ destitute persons of the state.

Key Points

- According to the proposal, the homes will be operated in available government buildings and rented buildings in case of non-availability of government buildings till the departmental building is constructed for the homeless, elderly, working women and helpless/ destitute persons of the state.
- With this approval of Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot, a large number of construction work of Chief Minister's rehabilitation homes will be done as well as clothes, beds and food items will be purchased for residential buildings. This amount will also be used in rent, tax rate, royalties and grants for assistance.
- It may be mentioned that the Chief Minister had announced to set up 45 Chief Minister Rehabilitation Homes of 75 residential capacity each in the budget for the year 2022-23. This financial approval has been given in the order of this announcement.
