Key Points

Appointment of High Court Judges

- Article 217 of the Constitution states that the Judge of a High Court shall be appointed by the President in consultation with the <u>Chief Justice of India (CJI)</u> and the <u>Governor of the State.</u>
- In the case of appointment of a Judge other than the Chief Justice, the Chief Justice of the High Court is consulted.
