<u>World Population Day</u> is observed on 11th July every year to raise awareness about global population issues and the importance of reproductive health and rights. It was established by the <u>United Nations</u> in 1989.

History:

- In 1989, the <u>United Nations Development Programme (UNDP)</u> proposed that July 11th be designated as World Population Day to draw global attention to the urgency and significance of population-related issues.
- UNDP was inspired by the public interest and awareness that was created by "Five Billion
 Day" on 11th July 1987 when the world's population reached 5 billion.
- Theme:
 - The theme of this 2024 WPD is "Leave no one behind, count everyone".
- In 2011, the global population reached the 7 billion mark, it stands at almost 7.9 billion in 2021, and it's expected to grow to around 8.5 billion in 2030, 9.7 billion in 2050, and 10.9 billion in 2100.
 - According to the UN's World Population dashboard, India's population 2024 stands at slightly over 1.428 billion.
