

Fortified Rice

Why in News

 Recently, there was confusion about coarse and yellow rice found in ration shops in Bareilly, Uttar Pradesh. After this, it was clarified by the <u>Food Safety and Standards Authority of India</u> (<u>FSSAI</u>) that it is <u>fortified</u> rice not plastic rice.

Key Points

- It is worth mentioning that for the solution of malnutrition, fortified rice is being distributed by the Central Government in the Child Development Scheme, Mid-Day Meal Scheme and Public Distribution System.
- Elements like vitamin **B2**, **B3** and iron have been included in this fortified rice.
- According to FSSAI, one kilogram of fortified rice is mixed with 50 kilograms of normal rice.
- There is a deficiency of nutrients like Vitamin B6, B3 and Vitamin E at the time of polishing of rice in rice meal. For this, the government has decided to distribute fortified rice.
