
Status Quo at Shambhu Border

Why in News?

Recently, <u>the Supreme Court</u> proposed to make an independent committee, comprising eminent persons, to **reach out to the protesters at Shambhu border** to find a solution to their demands.

Key Points

- The top court was addressing the Haryana government's plea challenging the **Punjab and** Haryana <u>High Court's</u> directive to remove, the barricades at the Shambhu border near Ambala, within a week, where farmers have been camping since 13th February 2024.
 - In February, the Haryana government set up barricades on the Ambala-New Delhi National Highway in response to plans by the <u>Samyukta Kisan Morcha</u> and <u>Kisan Mazdoor</u> <u>Morcha</u> to march to Delhi.
 - They were advocating for demands including a legal guarantee of <u>Minimum Support</u> <u>Price (MSP)</u> for crops.
- Since February, farmers have been stationed at the Shambhu and Khanauri borde r points between Punjab and Haryana after their march was halted by security forces.
