

Haryana's Vikas Rana Wins Gold

Why in News?

Recently, Vikas Rana, 31, daughter of a farmer in Haryana created history by winning the **maiden gold medal** for the country **in the cross country skiing championship in Germany**.

She has also represented India in the <u>Asian Games</u>.

Key Points

- She belongs to Sukhain Khurd village in the Uchana area of Jind.
- She won four gold, one silver and four bronze medals at the national games.
- She started her skiing practice at a young age and practiced most of the time in Gulmarg.

Asian Games

- The Asian Games is the biggest sports competition in Asia, held once every four years.
- The symbol for the Asian Games is the rising sun with interlocking rings.
- It is recognised by the International Olympic Committee.
- Asian Games were regulated by the Asian Games Federation from 1951 to 1978. Since 1982, the Olympic Council of Asia has regulated the Asian Games.
- India won 107 medals (28 gold, 38 silvers and 41 bronze) at the Asian Games 2023.
