

Chhattisgarh School Textbooks As Per NEP

Why in News?

Chhattisgarh has become the first state to take the initiative of **textbook writing and curriculum development** for school students in accordance with the norms of <u>National Education Policy (NEP), 2020</u> in collaboration with <u>National Council of Educational Research and Training.</u>

Key Points

- The aim is to **introduce changes in the curriculum by the next academic session** for Classes 1-3 and 6.
 - The Chhattisgarh Chief Minister has urged and directed the officers to expedite the process for the sincere implementation of the NEP in the state.

National Education Policy, 2020

- The National Education Policy (NEP), 2020 aims to address India's evolving development needs by overhauling the education system to meet 21st century goals and <u>Sustainable</u> <u>Development Goal 4 (SDG4)</u>, while preserving India's cultural heritage.
- It replaced the National Policy on Education, 1986, which was modified in 1992.

National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT)

- The NCERT is an autonomous organization that was established in 1961 underthe Societies Registration Act, 1860.
- It is the apex body for advising the central and state governments on matters related to school education.

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
