Contribution Towards Indian Education

- 4th Vice-Chancellor of Banaras Hindu University (1939-1948)
- Elected as the Chairman of UNESCO's executive board (1948)
- Chairman of University Education Commission (1949)

At National and Global Level

- Ambassador of India to the USSR (1949-1952)
- First Vice-President of India (1952-1962)
- Second President of India (1962-1967)

Awards and Recognition

- Knighthood in 1931
- Bharat Ratna in 1954
- Honorary membership of **British Royal Order of Merit** in 1963
- Templeton Prize in 1975 (for vital contributions in bridging the understanding between cultures and religions of the Eastern and Western hemispheres)

Notable Works

- Indian Philosophy (1923-27)
- The Philosophy of the Upanishads (1924)
- Eastern Religions and Western Thought (1939)
