Recently, **the Vice-President of India** emphasized the transformative power of literacy at the **International Literacy Day (ILD) 2024** celebrations held in New Delhi, urging a nationwide commitment to enhance education and celebrate linguistic diversity.

- The Vice-President praised the <u>National Education Policy</u>, 2020 for its potential to empower youth and recognize linguistic diversity. During the event, the <u>ULLAS (Understanding Lifelong Learning for All in Society)</u> DTH Channel was introduced to reach learners in remote areas, bridging literacy gaps.
- The roots of ILD trace back to the 1965 World Conference of Ministers of Education on the Eradication of Illiteracy in Tehran, Iran, which sparked the idea of a day dedicated to promoting literacy globally.
  - UNESCO officially declared 8<sup>th</sup> September as International Literacy Day during
    its 14<sup>th</sup> General Conference in 1967, and the world celebrated this special day for the
    first time that year, marking the beginning of a significant global observance.
