

Ban on Sugarcane Juice for Ethanol

The Centre's recent ban on using <u>sugarcane</u> juice and sugar syrup for ethanol production in the 2023-24 supply year aims to maintain adequate sugar availability for domestic consumption and stabilize prices. However, the government has permitted the use of **B-molasses for ethanol production**.

- The <u>Indian Sugar Mills Association (ISMA)</u> forecasts a 9% reduction in gross sugar production for the 2023-24 marketing year, further complicating the situation.
- India has emerged as the world's largest producer and consumer of sugar as well as the world's
 2nd largest exporter of sugar after Brazil, in Sugar Season (Oct-Sep) 2021-22.
