Recently, the **20th edition of the India-USA Joint Military Exercise YUDH ABHYAS**-**2024** began at the Mahajan Field Firing Ranges in Rajasthan.

- Exercise YUDH ABHYAS has been held annually since 2004, alternating between India and the USA.
- This year's exercise focuses on counter-terrorism operations in a semi-desert environment. The
 aim is to enhance joint military capability and cooperation under Chapter VII of the United
 Nations(UN) Charter.
 - Chapter VII of the UN charter provides the framework for the Security Council to take
 enforcement action, including determining threats to peace and taking non-military and
 military measures to maintain or restore international peace and security.
- Major Exercises Between India- USA: <u>Ex VAJRA PRAHAR</u> (Army), <u>SALVEX (Indian Navy)</u>, <u>Cope India</u> (Air Force) and <u>Malabar Exercise</u> (Quadrilateral naval exercise of India, USA, Japan and Australia).
