Sattriya (Assam)

- ▷ Introduced by: Sankaradeva (15th century A.D)
- ▶ Based on: Vaishnava faith
- ▷ Source of Name: 'Sattras' (Vaishnava monasteries)
- ▶ Narrates mythological stories of Vishnu
- ▶ Mentioned in the Natya Shastra (Bharat Muni)
- ▶ Inspired by: Bhakti Movement
- Status of classical dance: In Year 2000

- ▶ Narrates the stories of Lord Krishna
- ♦ Performed in group by male monks known as 'Bhokots'
