- Among them are 33,000 investors from Bihar, with Rs. 410 crore stuck.

 - Now, the refund limit has been raised to Rs. 50,000.
- Sahara India Group has launched the CRC Sahara Refund Portal, through which investors can claim their pending amounts.
- The district administration has also provided details about the portal on its official website.
 Investors are encouraged to promptly submit their claims through the portal to expedite the refund process.
