- National institutes and Regional Centers, under the <u>Department of Empowerment of Persons</u> with <u>Disabilities</u>, conducted awareness programs to promote an inclusive society and empower individuals to overcome hearing challenges.
- World Hearing Day (WHD) is celebrated on the 3<sup>rd</sup> March each year to raise awareness on how to prevent deafness and hearing loss and promote ear and hearing care across the world.
  - Globally, over 80% of ear and hearing care needs remain unmet.
- Theme of WHD 2024: Changing mindsets: Let's make ear and hearing care a reality for all!
  - Normal hearing range: 0-20 dBHL (Decibel Hearing Level).
  - A person who is not able to hear as well as someone with normal hearing hearing thresholds of 20 dB or better in both ears is said to have hearing loss.
    - Hard of hearing refers to people with hearing loss ranging from mild to severe.
      Deaf' people mostly have profound hearing loss, which- implies very little or no hearing.
