Man-Eating Leopard Hunt in Udaipur | Rajasthan | 05 Oct 2024

Why in News?

Recently, the authorities in **Udaipur district** are actively searching for a [leopard](#) responsible for multiple deaths.

Key Points

- A leopard has killed seven people in Udaipur district, search teams from the forest department, police, and [Indian Army](#) are trying to capture or eliminate the animal.
- Cages have been set up in various locations, and local villagers are assisting in the efforts.
- The [Chief Wildlife Warden](#) ordered the animal to be shot after a recent fatal attack on a 55-year-old

woman, and the hunt continues in **Gogunda and nearby areas.**

Chief Wildlife Warden

- **Authority:** The [Chief Wildlife Warden \(CWLW\)](#) is the statutory authority under the [Wildlife Protection Act, 1972](#) responsible for overseeing the Wildlife Wing of the state forest department.
- **Administrative Control:** The CWLW exercises full administrative control over [Protected Areas \(PAs\)](#) within the state, ensuring the implementation of wildlife protection measures.
- **Structure of Protected Areas:** Each Protected Area (PA) is generally classified as a Wildlife Division, with administrative responsibilities headed by a **Deputy Conservator of Forests (DCF)**.

Tragic Wasps Attack Claims Lives in Uttarakhand | Uttarakhand | 05 Oct 2024

Why in News?

Recently, a tragic incident in Uttarakhand highlights the dangers of [wildlife](#) encounters, resulting in the deaths of a father and son due to a [wasp attack](#).

Key Points

- **Incident Overview:**
 - A 47-year-old man and his eight-year-old son, tragically lost their lives after being attacked by wasps while grazing their cows in a forest in Jaunpur block of Uttarakhand's [Tehri Garhwal](#) district.
- **Wasps and Their Dangers:**
 - **Types and Aggression:**
 - Wasps, including yellow jackets, paper wasps, and hornets, can exhibit aggressive behavior when their nests are disturbed.
 - They possess smooth stingers that allow them to **sting multiple times** when threatened.
 - **Effects of Stings:**
 - A wasp sting typically causes immediate pain, swelling, and redness at the site due to the venom, which **contains toxic enzymes and proteins**.
 - Individuals may experience allergic reactions, ranging from mild symptoms like hives to severe **anaphylaxis, characterized by difficulty breathing, swelling, and potential loss of consciousness**.
 - **Multiple Stings and Risks:**
 - Multiple stings significantly increase the risk of severe systemic reactions, particularly in sensitive individuals.
 - [Anaphylaxis](#) can occur, necessitating immediate medical attention to prevent serious health complications or death.
 - **Prevention and Emergency Response:**
 - To prevent stings, avoid bright colors and floral patterns, use insect repellent, and seek professional help for nest removal.
 - In case of a sting, clean the area, apply a cold compress, and take pain relief if necessary. Severe reactions require urgent medical care.
