

# **UP Government To Ban Passenger Travel on Tractor-Trolleys | Uttar Pradesh | 14 Oct 2024**

# Why in News?

In response to a <u>series of accidents</u>, the Uttar Pradesh government is enforcing a ban on the use of tractor trolleys for passenger transport to improve <u>road safety</u>.

In 2021, road traffic injuries were the 13th leading cause of death in India and the 12th leading cause of health loss.

# Uttar Pradesh Scraps Street Race from Grand Prix | Uttar Pradesh | 14 Oct 2024

# Why in News?

The Uttar Pradesh government has intervened to cancel the proposed street race element for the <u>Indian</u> <u>Grand Prix at the Buddh International Circuit</u>, prioritizing logistics and safety.

 A Grand Prix is a premier motorsport event that forms part of the Formula One (F1) World Championship, as well as other racing series.

# **Key Points**

• Government Takes Control of Event Changes: The Uttar Pradesh government has assumed

control over a major change related to the **Indian Grand Prix**, canceling the idea of incorporating a street race element.

- Street Race Proposal Scrapped: Initial plans to include a street race element in the MotoGP event have been officially sidelined, in favor of a more streamlined approach.
- Focus on Safety and Logistics: The decision aligns with the state government's strategy to prioritize spectator safety, streamline event logistics, and reduce potential disruptions.
- Commitment to Buddh International Circuit: The government's move emphasizes maintaining
  the race at the <u>Buddh International Circuit</u>, which holds a long-term contract for hosting the
  MotoGP event.
- Centralizing Operations for Efficiency: By eliminating the street race, the authorities aim for a smoother event execution, avoiding the logistical challenges and risks associated with urban racing.
- **Strengthening International Sporting Presence**: This intervention reflects Uttar Pradesh's growing role in hosting international sporting events, bolstering its image as a capable and reliable venue for global competitions.

Aligning with MotoGP Organizers' Expectations: The decision also supports the MotoGP organizers' standards for participant and spectator safety, ensuring high-quality event management.



#### **Buddh International Circuit**

- The Buddh International Circuit is a motor racing track located in Jaypee Sports City, Greater
   Noida, Uttar Pradesh, named after Gautama Buddha, similar to the district of its location.
- The track was officially inaugurated on 18 October 2011.

- Article 14: Guarantees equality before the law and equal protection of the laws, prohibiting discrimination on the basis of race, religion, sex and place of birth.
- Article 15(3): Allows the State to make special provisions for women and children.
- Article 16: Provides equal opportunities in matters of public employment.
- Article 39(d): Calls for equal pay for equal work for both men and women.
- Article 42: Directs the State to make provisions for ensuring just and humane conditions of work and maternity relief.

# Madhya Pradesh CM To Woo Investments in Hyderabad | Madhya Pradesh | 14 Oct 2024


# Why in News?

# Madhya Pradesh: DRI seizes 112 kg Mephedrone | Madhya Pradesh | 14 Oct 2024

## Why in News?

Recently, the <u>Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI)</u> busted an illegal mephedrone factory in Jhabua, Madhya Pradesh, seizing a large quantity of <u>narcotics</u>.

### **Key Points**

- **DRI Operation in Jhabua**: The Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) uncovered an illegal factory manufacturing mephedrone in Jhabua, Madhya Pradesh.
  - The operation led to the seizure of **112 kg of mephedrone**, a synthetic drug, with a high street value.
  - Multiple individuals involved in the illegal drug manufacturing and distribution network were arrested during the operation.
- **Impact on Drug Trafficking**: The bust is considered a significant blow to narcotics trafficking in the region, as mephedrone is a popular illegal drug in the market.
- **Continued Vigilance**: Authorities have increased vigilance and are monitoring the area to prevent further **illegal drug activities in the region.**
- **Mephedrone and its Risks**: Mephedrone, also known as **"meow meow" or "MD,"** is a highly addictive synthetic drug, with severe health risks, making its illegal production a priority for law enforcement to tackle.

# **Mephedrone**

- It is also known as 4-methylmethcathinone, 4-MMC and 4-methylephedrone.
- It is a synthetic stimulant drug of the amphetamine and cathinone classes.
- Other names: drone, M-CAT, white magic, 'meow meow', and bubble.
- It has a role as a **xenobiotic** and an environmental contaminant.
- It has been linked to a range of adverse effects on both physical and mental health.
- Users commonly report increased alertness, euphoria, and enhanced sociability, but these positive effects come at a cost.
- Health impacts:
  - Anxiety, paranoia, nausea, and insomnia are among the negative side effects experienced by individuals under the influence of this synthetic stimulant.
  - Prolonged use of Mephedrone has been associated with more severe consequences, including cardiovascular issues, hallucinations, and even instances of aggressive behaviour.
  - The drug's impact on mental health raises concerns about its potential for addiction and long-term psychological harm.
- It is banned in India under the <u>Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act</u>, <u>1985</u>.
