#### About:

- Jayaprakash Narayan was born on 11th October 1902, in Sitabdiara, Bihar.
- He was an **Indian Independence activist**, social reformer and political leader.

### Ideology:

- Influenced by Marxist ideas after studying in the United States.
- Strongly opposed British rule in India and advocated for independence through socialist principles.
- His objective was to bring about societal change in line with the <u>ideals of Sarvodaya</u>,
  a Gandhian philosophy emphasising progress for all.

## Key Works:

- Joined the <u>Indian National Congress</u> in 1929 and participated in the <u>civil</u> <u>disobedience movement</u> and <u>Quit India Movement</u>.
- Co-founded the Congress Socialist Party, advocating for a left-wing approach within the Congress Party.
- Promoted the <u>Bhoodan Gramdan Movement</u>, (initiated by <u>Acharya Vinoba Bhave</u>) advocating land redistribution for the landless.
- In 1959, proposed a decentralized political structure with a four-tier system of governance.
- He led the Total Revolution movement against the <u>Emergency (1975 to 1977)</u>
  and became a vocal critic of corruption and authoritarianism.

## Death and Award:

He died on 8<sup>th</sup> October 1979, and was posthumously awarded the <u>Bharat Ratna</u> in 1999.
