Key Points

- Governor C.P. Radhakrishnan administered the oath of office at the Raj Bhavan in Ranchi.
- <u>Chief Minister Hemant Soren</u> and **Speaker Rabindra Nath Mahato** attended the swearing-in ceremony, besides several judges and senior government officials.

Appointment of High Court Judges

- Article 217 of the Constitution states that the Judge of a High Court shall be appointed by the President in consultation with the Chief Justice of India (CJI) and the Governor of the State.
- In the case of appointment of a Judge other than the Chief Justice, the Chief Justice of the High Court is consulted.
