Recently, the 3<sup>rd</sup> edition of <u>Exercise AUSTRAHIND</u> commenced at the Foreign Training Node in Maharashtra, in November 2024.

- The exercise, conducted **annually**, alternates **between India and Australia**, aiming to enhance military cooperation and interoperability in joint operations.
- The exercise supports joint planning and sub-conventional operations in semi-urban, semi-desert terrain, focusing on counterterrorism, physical fitness, tactical drills, and high-level coordination as mentioned under <u>Chapter VII of the UN mandate</u>
- The exercise will be conducted in two phases combat conditioning and tactical training phase and validation phase.
- The Exercise reflects growing defense cooperation under the <u>India-Australia Comprehensive</u>
  <u>Strategic Partnership (2020)</u>.
- Other Exercises between India and Australia are AUSINDEX, and PITCHBLACK.
- Defence Cooperation between India and Australia:
  - Mutual Logistics Support Agreement
  - Both are members of the <u>Quad</u>, <u>Commonwealth</u>, <u>Indian Ocean Rim Association</u>
    (<u>IORA</u>), ASEAN Regional Forum, Asia Pacific Partnership on Climate and Clean
    Development, and have participated in the <u>East Asia Summits</u>.
