

## **Accessibility for Disabled Persons**

Recently, The <u>Supreme Court</u> affirmed that the <u>right</u> to access environments, services, and <u>opportunities</u> for <u>persons with disabilities (PWDs)</u> is a <u>human and <u>fundamental right</u>.</u>

- Accessibility: The court urged the government to create universal accessible public and private spaces, services, and products as mandated in Rule 15 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017.
  - Rule 15 of the Rights of <u>Persons with Disabilities Rules</u>, <u>2017</u> covers accessibility of physical environment, transport, and information and communication technology.
- Legal Framework: The <u>Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act</u>, 2016 aims to protect and promote the rights of persons with disabilities (PwDs).
  - It aims to give effect to the <u>United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with</u>
    <u>Disabilities (UNCRPD)</u>, which India ratified in 2007.
  - A person with a benchmark disability is defined as someone with at least 40% of a specified disability.
- Initiatives Related to the Empowerment of the Disabled: <u>Assistance to Disabled Persons</u> for Purchase/fitting of Aids and Appliances, <u>Accessible India Campaign</u>, and <u>Unique</u> <u>Disability Identification Portal</u>.
