

14th National Voters' Day

The President of India recently addressed the **14th** National Voters' Day Celebrations in New Delhi and presented the **Best Electoral Practices Awards for the year 2023** to the State and District level officers for their outstanding performance in the conduct of elections during 2023.

- Since 2011, National Voters' Day has been celebrated on 25th January every year to mark the foundation day of the **Election Commission of India.**
 - 'Nothing Like Voting, I Vote For Sure' is the theme of National Voters' Day 2024.
- ECI initiatives for General Elections 2024 was also unveiled as a part of the event.
 - Till now, **17 general elections** and more than 400 assembly elections have been conducted by the Election Commission.

Constitutional Provisions

Part XV - Article 324 to 329

Structure

- 1 Chief Election Commissioner and 2 Election Commissioners appointed by President
- Tenure- 6 years, or up to the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier
- Retiring ECs eligible for further appointment by the govt.
- Removal of CEC- Resolution on the ground of proven misbehaviour or incapacity, with majority of 2/3rd members present and voting, supported by more than 50% of the total strength of the house

Major Roles and Responsibilities



- Determining Electoral Constituencies
- Preparing/Revising electoral rolls
- Notifying the schedules and dates of elections
- Registering political parties and granting them the status of national or state parties
- Issuing the Model Code of Conduct (MCC) for political parties
- Advising the President on matters concerning the disqualification of MPs

Challenges

- Truncated Tenure of CEC
- Executive Influence in Appointments
- Dependence on Centre for Finance
- Lack of Independent Staff
