## Why in News?

Recently, A state-level <u>transgender</u> cultural event was held at the **Mukta Kashi Stage of the Mahant Ghasidas Museum in Raipur.** 

■ This event was a **proactive initiative against the** <u>social evil of dowry</u>, which is still prevalent in many parts of the country, particularly in underdeveloped states.

## **Key Points**

- The event was organised jointly by the **Department of Culture and Archaeology** and the **Chhattisgarh Mitwa Sankalp Committee.**
- Transgender artists also performed dance fusion of Chhattisgarhi, Rajasthani, <u>Kathak</u>, <u>Odissi</u> and <u>Lavani</u> besides trans-models dazzle ramp with Chhattisgarhi and rainbow themes.
  - Senior community members honored all the artists with coconuts, shawls, and mementos.

## **Transgender**

- According to the <u>Transgenders Persons Act. 2019</u>, transgender means a person whose gender does not match with the gender assigned to that person at birth.
- It includes trans-person with intersex variations, gender-queer and people having such socio-cultural identities as kinnar, hijra, aaravani and jogta.
- India's 2011 Census was the first census in its history to incorporate the number of 'trans' population of the country. The report estimated that 4.8 million Indians identified as transgender.
