Recently, Ireland, Norway, and Spain have announced that they will **formally recognize the** state of Palestine on 28th May 2024.

- In response, Israel ordered the immediate return of its ambassadors from Ireland, Norway, and Spain, expressing strong opposition and dissatisfaction.
- Also, recently at the <u>United Nations General Assembly</u>, 143 of 193 UN member countries voted in favor of granting full membership to Palestine.
 - India has always supported the <u>two-state solution</u> and was one of the first non-Arab nations to recognise Palestine as a state in 1988.
 - India has also recognised the **Palestine Liberation Organization.**ise Palestine
