## Why in News?

Recently, the <u>Pradhan Mantri Colleges of Excellence</u> was inaugurated by the Union Home Minister in all **55 districts of Madhya Pradesh.** 

## **Key Points**

- Madhya Pradesh has become the first state to implement the New Education Policy (NEP) 2020.
  - These colleges are started by the state government, to offer courses aligned with the New Education Policy 2020.
  - NEP was introduced to focus on holistic development of youth rather than just awarding degrees.
- It includes teaching both academic subjects and life skills. The emphasis is on encouraging out-of-the-box thinking instead of traditional thinking in students.

## **National Education Policy 2020**

- The National Education Policy 2020 seeks to tackle the evolving development needs of India.
  - It calls for a comprehensive overhaul of the education system, including its regulations and management, to establish a modern system that aligns with 21stcentury educational goals, including <u>Sustainable Development Goal 4 (SDG4)</u>, while respecting India's cultural heritage and values.
- It replaces the thirty-four year old <u>National Policy on Education</u>, <u>1986</u>, **modified in 1992** (NPE 1986/92).
