Recently, the **Union Minister of State for Health and Family Welfare** provided updates on the <u>Pradhan Mantri Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission (PM-ABHIM)</u> in a written reply in the Lok Sabha.

- About: The PM Atmanirbhar Swasth Bharat Yojana (PMASBY), which has now been renamed as PM-ABHIM is one of the largest pan-India <u>Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS)</u> with certain Central Sector Components.
 - It was launched in 2021 by the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare with the outlay of Rs. 64,180 Crores for the scheme period (2021-22 to 2025-26).
- Objective: It aims to strengthen India's healthcare infrastructure systems at all levelsprimary, secondary, and tertiary- and enhance pandemic preparedness.
 - It supplements the <u>National Health Mission</u> (**NHM**) by addressing **infrastructure gaps** in public health facilities.
- The initiative includes constructing 17,788 <u>Ayushman Arogya Mandirs</u> in rural areas, 11,024 urban <u>Health & Wellness Centres</u>, 3,382 Block Public <u>Health Units</u>, 730 District <u>Integrated Public Health Labs</u>, and 602 Critical Care Hospital Blocks in districts with over 5 lakh population.
