

## **Infectious Respiratory Particles**

The <u>World Health Organization (WHO)</u> has introduced a standardised term, 'infectious respiratory particles' (IRPs), to describe pathogens transmitted through the air.

- This move aims to unify terminology across sectors, enhancing scientific and policy guidance while improving public communication regarding respiratory infections like <u>Covid-19</u>, Influenza, measles, <u>Middle East Respiratory Syndrome (MERS)</u>, <u>Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome (SARS)</u>, and <u>tuberculosis (TB)</u>.
- The WHO's clarification distinguishes IRPs from previously used terms like 'aerosols' and 'droplets,' emphasising a continuum of particle sizes.
