Why in News

On November 10, 2021, Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot approved proposals for financial sanction of Rs 695.40 crore for 49 water supply projects under the [Jal Jeevan Mission](#).

Key Points

- Under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) by the Finance Department, 41 water supply schemes worth more than Rs 5 crore, revised cost of 6 approved projects, including construction of Anicut at Sancholi (Sawai Madhopur) on River Morel and transmission pipeline project from Surajpura to Sambhar, total A proposal for financial sanction of Rs 695.40 crore was sent for 49 projects.
- In order to provide pure drinking water in rural areas under JJM, it was announced in the budget for the year 2021-22 to connect 20 lakh households with drinking water connection in a phased manner.
- In the current financial year in the state, an amount of Rs 1077.88 crore has been spent so far by the state government for providing '[Har Ghar Nal Connection](#)' to rural families under JJM. Rajasthan is also one of the leading states in the country in terms of expenditure on rural drinking water projects in JJM.
