Recently, the **Ministry of Science & Technology** unveiled **Kisan Kavach**, India's first **anti-pesticide bodysuit**, that **prevents** chemicals from **leaching into the skin**.

- Kisan Kavach: Kisan Kavach is designed to protect farmers from the harmful effects of <u>pesticide</u> <u>exposure</u>, including respiratory disorders, vision loss, and even death.
  - It is made of **'oxime fabric'** that can **chemically breakdown** any of the common pesticides that get **sprayed onto cloth or body** during spraying operations.
  - The manufacturing process involves **nucleophilic-mediated hydrolysis** on cotton fabric to **deactivate pesticides**.
  - It is developed by **BRIC-inStem, Bangalore**, in collaboration with **Sepio Health Pvt.** Ltd.
- Pesticide Use: According to the Food and Agricultural Organisation (FAO), India used over 61,000 tonnes of pesticide in 2020.
  - India produces about four times more pesticide than it uses.
- Pesticide Poisoning: Globally, 385 million cases of acute pesticide poisoning occur annually, causing 11,000 deaths, with highest impact in South Asia.
