The Northern Command

- It is a command of the Indian Army, with its headquarters in Udhampur.
- The current **General Officer Commanding-in-Chief** of the Northern Command is **Lieutenant General M. V. Suchindra Kumar.**
- The Northern Command was **originally formed in 1908** as the Northern Army of the British Indian Army.
- It was disbanded in 1947 after India gained independence, but was re-established in 1972.
