

Commissioning of Nilgiri, Surat and Vaghsheer

The <u>Indian Navy</u> announced the commissioning of **Nilgiri**, **Surat**, and <u>Vaghsheer</u>, built at <u>Mazagon</u> <u>Dock Shipbuilders Limited (MDL)</u>, on 15th January 2025, at Mumbai.

- Nilgiri: The lead ship of <u>Project 17A</u>, represents a major upgrade over the Shivalik-class frigates, featuring advanced **stealth technology** and state-of-the-art weapon systems to strengthen naval defense.
- Surat: The fourth and final destroyer under <u>Project 15B</u>, is an enhanced version of the Kolkata-class destroyers, equipped with <u>long-range missiles</u> and indigenous weapons systems.
 - Project 15B is an initiative by the Indian Navy to design and construct four advanced quided-missile destroyers
- Vaghsheer: The sixth submarine in the <u>Scorpene-class (Project 75)</u>, is one of the quietest diesel-electric submarines globally, capable of <u>anti-surface and anti-submarine warfare</u>, surveillance, and special operations.
 - Project-75 (India) aims to build 18 conventional submarines and six nuclear-powered submarines for the Indian Navy.
