Indian Army Day is celebrated annually on 15th January to commemorate the appointment of General (later Field Marshal) K. M. Cariappa as the first Indian Commander-in-Chief of the Indian Army in 1949.

- He succeeded British General Sir F. R. R. Bucher, marking a historic moment in India's postindependence military leadership.
- 2025 Theme: 'Samarth Bharat, Saksham Sena' (Capable India, Empowered Army).
- Hosts: Pune hosts the Army Day parade for the first time, emphasizing its military significance.
 - It is home to key establishments like the Southern Command, <u>National Defence</u> <u>Academy (NDA)</u>, and <u>DRDO</u> facilities.
- Year of Defence Reforms: The Indian government has declared 2025 as the <u>"Year of Defence</u> <u>Reforms,"</u> aiming to <u>integrate theatre commands</u>, enhance <u>tri-services</u> synergy, streamline military procurement, and promote indigenous capabilities.
- Armed Forces Veterans' Day: Celebrated annually on 14th January to honor the service and sacrifices of Indian armed forces veterans.
 - It marks the retirement of KM Cariappa in 1953.
- Indian Navy Day: 4th December.
- Indian Air Force Day: 8th October.
