Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Mohan Yadav is on a four-day visit to Japan (28-31 January 2025) to promote investment opportunities in the state and invite Japanese investors to the Global Investors Summit (GIS) 2025 in Bhopal.

 - Discussed strengthening <u>India-Japan relations</u> and boosting cooperation at the state level.
- Discussion with Director of A&D Medicals:
 - MP Government offered 75 acres of land at subsidized rates in Ujjain's medical & pharmaceutical park.
 - A&D Medicals is interested in setting up a manufacturing facility in MP in 2025.
- Meeting with Chairman of East Japan Railway Company:
 - Discussed economic collaboration between Japan and Madhya Pradesh.
 - Attended by Indian Ambassador to Japan Sibi George.
- Talks with Toyota Motor Corporation's Senior Leadership:
 - CM pitched Madhya Pradesh as an investment destination for Toyota.
