

## Vijay Diwas: 50 Years of Indo-Pak War

## Why in News

India will celebrate 50 Years of Indo-Pak War, also called Swarnim Vijay Varsh on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2020.

- Inaugural event of the celebration will be held at the <u>National War Memorial (NWM)</u> in New Delhi which will be attended by the Prime Minister.
  - The National War Memorial is a tribute to the soldiers who laid down their lives defending the nation, post-independence it also commemorates the soldiers who participated and made the supreme sacrifice in Peacekeeping Missions, and Counter Insurgency Operations.

## **Key Points**

- Vijay Diwas is observed on 16<sup>th</sup> December every year to mark India's victory over Pakistan in the 1971 war.
- The Government of India decided on 3<sup>rd</sup> December 1971, that India would go for war with Pakistan to save Bengali Muslims and Hindus.
- This war was fought between India and Pakistan for 13 days.
- On 16<sup>th</sup> December 1971, the chief of the Pakistani forces with 93,000 soldiers had surrendered unconditionally to the allied forces consisting of Indian Army and Mukti Bahini in Dhaka.
  - Mukti Bahini refers to the armed organizations that fought against the Pakistan Army during the Bangladesh Liberation War. It was a guerrilla resistance movement.
- Bangladesh was born on this day. Hence, Bangladesh celebrates its independence day (Bijoy Dibos) on 16<sup>th</sup> December every year.
