

Fashion Show Controversy During Ramzan

Why in News?

A fashion show held during the <u>Islamic holy month of Ramzan</u> at **Gulmarg**, a tourist spot in north Kashmir sparked controversy. J&K Chief Minister sought a report to take appropriate action.

Key Points

- Event Details:
 - A fashion show featuring male and female models was organized to mark the 15th anniversary of the designer label, Shivan & Narresh.
 - The event took place against the backdrop of snow-laden slopes in Gulmarg, and models showcased the label's skiwear collection.
- Public Outrage and Online Backlash:
 - In the past two days, videos of the event went viral online, triggering objections from many netizens in Kashmir.
 - Critics condemned the event for being inappropriate during the Islamic holy month of Ramzan.

Ramzan

- About:
 - Ramadan is considered the holiest month in the Islamic calendar, during which Muslims fast from dawn until sunset, abstaining from food, drink, and other physical needs.
- Fasting:
 - Fasting during Ramadan is seen as a way to purify the soul and gain a deeper understanding of God's blessings.
 - Besides fasting, Muslims are encouraged to engage in acts of charity, prayer, and good deeds during Ramadan.
- Ouran:
 - Muslims believe that the Quran, the holy book of Islam, was first revealed to Prophet
 Muhammad during Ramadan, specifically on Laylat al-Qadr, the Night of Power, which is believed to fall within the last ten nights of the month.
- Eid al-Fitr:
 - The end of Ramadan is marked by <u>Eid al-Fitr</u>, a major festival in the Islamic calendar.
