



Rajasthan Public Service Commission (RPSC) Strategy

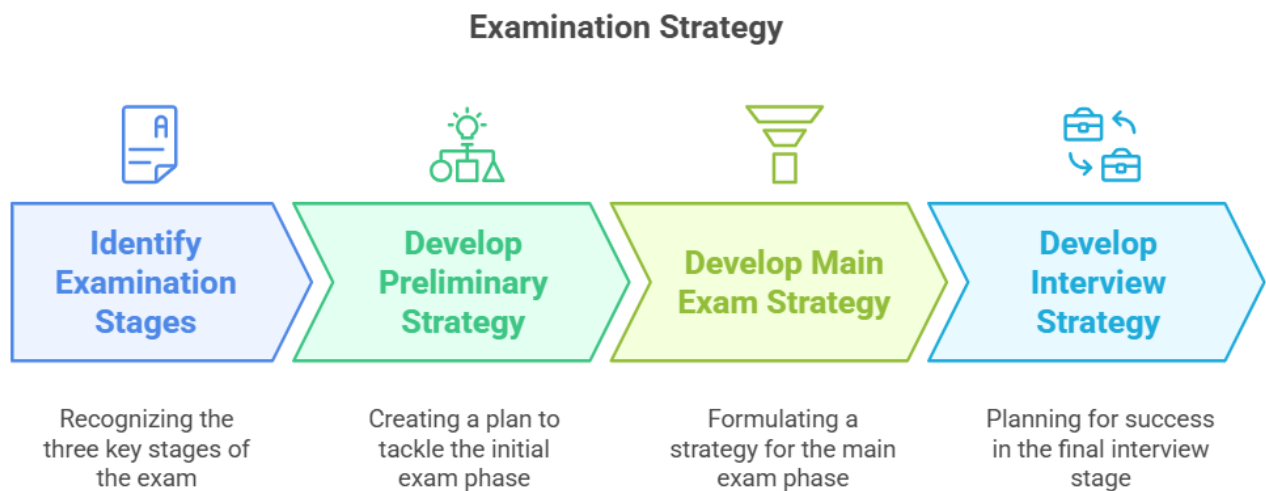

Review of Previous Years' Question Papers

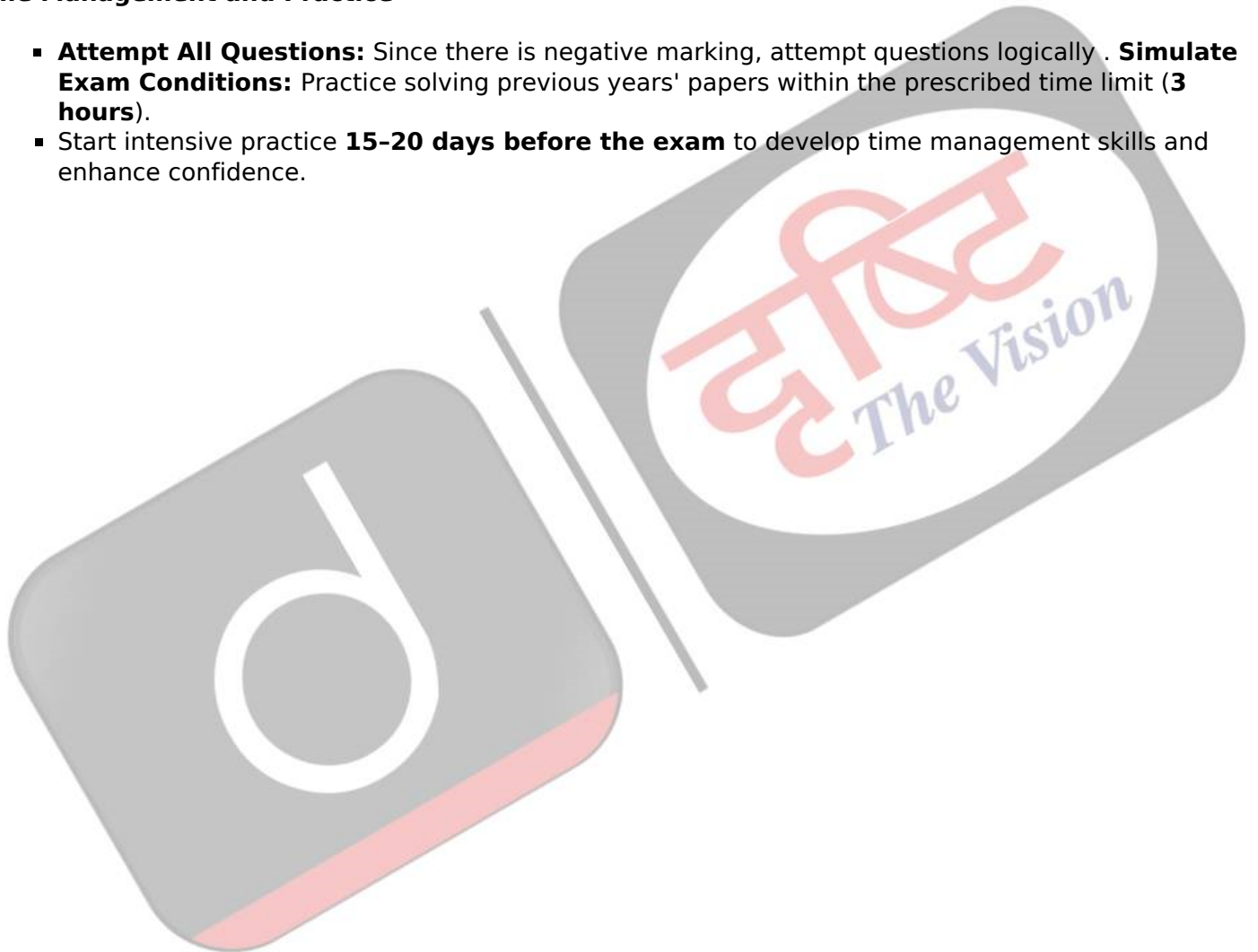
- Analyze the questions asked in the last **5 to 10 years**.
